| Subject: | COVID-19 PFIZER BOOSTER GUIDANCE FOR STAFF   |

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide direction and to facilitate the administration of **COVID-19 Pfizer booster** vaccinations for staff who have received the COVID-19 Pfizer vaccination series.

The <u>CDC ACIP Pfizer Booster dose recommendations</u> confirm that the **COVID-19 Pfizer booster** is available for all staff who meet the below qualifications:

- It has been more than 6 months since the staff member received the second COVID-19 Pfizer dose.
- The staff member <u>has not</u> received the third "additional" dose of the COVID-19 Pfizer dose.
  - Those who have already received the additional dose (due to immunocompromised status) are not eligible for the booster shot at this time.

A booster dose of the Pfizer vaccine and the Influenza vaccine may be given during the same encounter. When vaccines are administered at the same encounter, <u>the CDC recommendation</u> is to do so at separate sites (opposite arms if possible, or otherwise at least one inch apart). The COVID-19 Pfizer booster is available for qualified staff during specified vaccination clinics at each institution. Refer to the <u>Vaccination Clinic Schedule</u> for site-specific schedules. At this time, there are no recommendations with respect to booster doses for the staff who have received Janssen or Moderna vaccinations. Please direct all questions to- <u>EHP@cdcr.ca.gov</u>.
