This letter is to provide notice to the California Correctional Supervisors Organization (CCSO) that the Department of State Hospitals (DSH) is implementing Governor Newsom's order mandating all eligible workers in health care and high-risk congregate settings, to receive their COVID-19 booster by February 1, 2022.

Governor Gavin Newsom <u>announced</u> new booster requirements to better protect all Californians as the Omicron variant becomes the dominant COVID-19 strain in the nation.
