The Court, having reviewed the parties' joint statement dated January 3, 2022 and having considered all relevant pleadings filed to date, orders as follows:


1. The January 10, 2022 case management conference statement is continued to **May 26, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** The parties' joint CMC statement is due no later than **May 19, 2022.**

1 2. The Court adopts the dates on page 8 of the case management conference statement and
2 are as follows:

Date	Matter
Feb. 18, 2022	All depositions to precede filing of class certification and decertification motions shall be substantially completed.
April 8, 2022	Plaintiffs' motion to certify the class in the <i>Bojorquez</i> action to be filed and served.
April 8, 2022	Defendants' motions to decertify the remaining supervisor subclass in the <i>Stoetzl, Kuhn, and Shaw</i> matters to be filed and served.
June 17, 2022	Any parties' opposition to a motion addressing class certification or class decertification to be filed and served.
July 8, 2022	Reply briefs to any of the motions addressing class certification or class decertification to be filed and served. Deadline for opposition and reply briefs is subject to modification in the event completion of any necessary time and motion studies is not possible due to delays in access to institutions caused by impacts of the pandemic or other unforeseen events.
July 27, 2022	Class certification and decertification motions to be heard; all hearings set for 9:00 a.m.
Sept. 22, 2022	Last day for parties to participate in further mediation.
Oct. 4, 2022	Parties shall file a joint report to the Court advising of the status of this Proceeding, including the parties' ability to complete time and motion studies and whether the parties have agreed to a bench trial on compensability.
Mar. 6, 2023	Commencement of final Phase II trial.
